- July 10 - For weaving the carpet \$2.00.
- July 14 - Berries 52c & sugar 40c.
- August 29 - Berries 60c, Tea 50c, & 3# beef 51c.
- September 3 - 5 pounds butter \$1.00.
- Nov. 5 - Overalls for Allie 50c and Baldwin shoes 65c.
- Nov. 24 - School books \$2.50 and Spelling book for Lizzie 30c.
- Dec. 17 - Broom 20c, Sugar 29c, and postage 12c.
- Dec. 20 - 2 cords wood \$4.00.
- Jan. 6 - 124# beef \$6.82.
- Jan. 22 - Tea \$1.00, Sugar \$1.00, Flour 93c, and matches 25c.
- Feb. 19 - Tea \$1.00, Sugar \$1.00, Cheese 36c.
- Feb. 21 - Coffee 80c, Raisons 40c.

These are only a few of the items listed. From June 20, 1879 to June 18, 1880, John McKenzie's family spent \$309.68 for food, clothing, and repairs around the home.

- August 12 - Chimney for lamp 12c, Fish 25c.

- Sept. 20 - Tea & Coffee \$1.92.
- Nov. 8 - 1 lamp \$1.25.
- Nov. 10 - Salt 15c, Kerosine 40c.
- Dec. 7 - Sundries 75c.

 April - Paid school taxes for two years \$11.12.
 June 14 - Tomato plants 25c.
 Oct. 16 - Window glass 10c.

From June 23, 1882 to Dec. 26, 1883, the family spent \$330.61.
